Summary of the role

For the 2025 national election cycle MiGreat will be running an election campaign. The goal of this campaign is to push our goals – freedom of movement and equal rights for all migrants – into the public discourse and encourage parties to adopt pro-migration policies into their programmes. The Election Campaign Intern will support this campaign from start to finish. They will craft campaign strategy alongside the rest of the team, work independently on research & content creation, but also support collaborative tasks like planning demos and actions.

It is possible to do the role as a curricular internship but applicants from all walks of life are encouraged to apply!

Tasks

- Support the election campaign team in its day-to-day tasks;
- Research and analyze current party programmes;
- Create accessible educational content for our website and social media to inform voter opinions;
- Connect with party members;
- Organize protests and actions.
